**ITEM 2:
Act of interment**

Scattering only: \$300 ⁰⁰ per person
Scattering with memorial plaque: \$400 ⁰⁰ per person
Burial: \$650 ⁰⁰ per person

TEMPORARY INTERMENT (The Meadow strongly encourages this option!) In choosing temporary interment, you're agreeing to the reuse of your gravesite after fifty (50) years. Meaning that, fifty years after your burial occurs, The Meadow regains the right to use this particular site again. Because of our soil and climate, after 50 years, we really don't expect to find many remains. However, while we are excavating the space for its next use, we will watch carefully. Found remains will be gathered and dealt with according to the wishes expressed by the original buyer on their *Remains Directive* form.

WHY CONSIDER THIS TYPE OF INTERMENT?

From a philosophical standpoint, most of us have chosen The Meadow as a reflection of our values – We may prize the simplicity and economical aspects of natural burial. We may want to minimize our end-of-life environmental footprint. We may also desire to model good stewardship practices. We've carefully chosen what to do with our possessions and placed our money on a path into the future.

By using temporary interment, we relinquish our remains to the living soil of Earth and bequeath our hold that it may thrive. From a practical standpoint, temporary burial allows the soil to continue participating in the ongoing cycles of life. It allows the land to continue serving our community and those who come after us, and it allows The Meadow to earn the money needed for care and upkeep as the years pass.
